**I. General Statement of Purpose**

This document establishes a formal Memorandum of Understanding between the SUNY Cobleskill's Bachelor degree program listed above and SUNY ESF's Master of Landscape Architecture program.

The purpose is to facilitate the admission of qualified SUNY Cobleskill Bachelor of Technology in Landscape Contracting degree recipients into SUNY ESF's Master of Landscape Architecture degree program.

**II. Requirements and Terms**

- A. Students must earn a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or above at the time of application to the graduate program, and maintain an overall GPA of 3.25 or above at the time of completion and graduation from their Bachelor degree program at SUNY Cobleskill.
- B. Students will receive a minimum grade of "C" or better on all required courses for the Bachelor degree program at SUNY Cobleskill, resulting in a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher.
- C. Completion of the Bachelor degree program at SUNY Cobleskill.
- D. Obtain a GRE score of the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile or better for the entrance to the MLA program.
- E. Completion of the admissions application for SUNY ESF's Master of Landscape Architecture program.
- F. If offered acceptance to the MLA programs, SUNY Cobleskill students must accept responsibility for completing any academic deficiencies at ESF as outlined by the Admissions Committee.
- G. Students will provide SUNY ESF with a final transcript listing degree posted and cumulative GPA for the Bachelor degree program at SUNY Cobleskill.
