I. Statement of Purpose

This document establishes a formal Memorandum of Understanding between SUNY Cobleskill's Bachelor of Science in Communication in Technology degree program and LIU Hudson's Master in Business Administration and Master in Public Administration.

II. Requirements and Terms

Applicants must demonstrate an overall strong potential for success in graduate study based on their undergraduate academic performance. Specifically:

- A. Complete the Bachelor of Science in Communication in Technology at SUNY Cobleskill.
- B. Attain a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or above.
- C. Attain a minimum grade of "C" on all required courses for the Bachelor of Science in Communication in Technology.
- D. Complete the admissions application, including:
 - 1. two letters of recommendation
 - 2. final transcripts.
- E. Interview with LIU Hudson's MBA/MPA program director.
- F. The GMAT is waived.
- G. Application fee is waived.

III. Review and Revision of this Memorandum of Understanding

This agreement will be reviewed annually. Should either party decide to terminate this agreement, notification will be given to the other party in writing, not less than six months prior to the proposed date of termination.
