SUNY BUFFALO STATE Master of Science in Education Childhood Education Initial Teaching Certification (Grades 1-6)

I. General Statement of Purpose

This document establishes a formal Memorandum of Understanding between SUNY Cobleskill's Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Studies, Birth to Age 5 degree program and SUNY Buffalo State's Master of Science in Education - Childhood Education Initial Teaching Certification (Grades 1-6), graduate degree program.

To facilitate the admission of qualified SUNY Cobleskill Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Studies, Birth to Age 5 degree recipients into SUNY Buffalo State's Master of Science Education - Childhood Education Initial Teaching Certification (Grades 1-6), graduate degree program.

II. Requirements and Terms

- A. Students must earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above at the time of application to the graduate program, and maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 or above at the time of completion and graduation with the Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Studies, Birth to Age 5 degree.
- B. Students will receive a minimum grade of C or better on all required courses for the Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Studies, Birth to Age 5 degree program at SUNY Cobleskill, resulting in a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- C. Completion of the Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Studies, Birth to Age 5 degree program at SUNY Cobleskill.
- D. Completion of the admissions application for SUNY Buffalo State's Master of Science Education, Childhood Education Initial Teaching Certification (Grades 1-6) including:
 - 1) 6 credit hours of study in English, mathematics, science and social studies. (Note: ENGL 101 and 102 do not count towards the English requirement)
 - 2) A 30 credit concentration in a degree in the Liberal Arts and Sciences (example: English.)
 - 3) Two years of high school (High School transcript should be submitted with application if applicable) OR two semesters of college study in one foreign language (American Sign Language I and II will fulfill this requirement.)
 - 4) A personal statement following the prescribed format as outlined in the application materials.
 - 5) Three letters of reference on special departmental forms that attest to the applicant's potential as a graduate student and a teacher. (Note: Two references must be from college professors.)

E. Students will provide SUNY Buffalo State with a final transcript listing degree posted and cumulative GPA for the Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Studies, Birth to Age 5 program.

III. Benefits and Advantages

& Educational Leadership Department

- A. Admission to SUNY Buffalo State's Master of Science in Education Childhood Education Initial Teaching Certification (Grades 1-6), graduate degree program, leading to initial teacher certification for qualified SUNY Cobleskill students.
- B. To attract qualified students to both institutions who wish to pursue a Master's degree leading to NYS Teacher Certification, Grades 1-6.

IV. Review and Revision of this Memorandum of Understanding

This agreement will be reviewed in May of each academic year. Should either party desire to terminate this agreement, notification will be given to the other party, in writing, not less than six months prior to the proposed date of termination. Any students currently in the graduate program at SUNY Buffalo State will be allowed to complete their Master's degree if this agreement is terminated in the future.
