I. General Statement of Purpose

This document establishes a formal Memorandum of Understanding between the SUNY Cobleskill's Bachelor of Technology in Therapeutic Horsemanship degree program and The Sage College's Master of Arts in Counseling and Community Psychology and Master of Arts in Community Psychology graduate degree programs.

The purpose is to facilitate the admission of qualified SUNY Cobleskill Bachelor of Technology in Therapeutic Horsemanship degree recipients into The Sage College's Master of Arts in Counseling and Community Psychology and Master of Arts in Community Psychology graduate degree programs.

II. Requirements and Terms

- A. Students must earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above at the time of application to the graduate program, and maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 or above at the time of completion and graduation with the Bachelor of Technology in Therapeutic Horsemanship degree.
- B. Students will receive a minimum grade of "C" or better on all required courses for the Bachelor of Technology in Therapeutic Horsemanship degree at SUNY Cobleskill, resulting in a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- C. Completion of the Bachelor of Technology in Therapeutic Horsemanship degree program at SUNY Cobleskill.
- D. Students will meet the academic requirements for admission including specific coursework as outlined on the attached guide sheet.
- E. Completion of the admissions application for The Sage College's Master of Arts in Counseling and Community Psychology or the Master of Arts in Community Psychology graduate degree program.
- F. Students will provide The Sage College with a final transcript listing degree posted and cumulative GPA for the Bachelor of Technology in Therapeutic Horsemanship degree program.
