

1+1 Transfer Agreement
 between
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK
COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY AT COBLESKILL
 and
FULTON-MONTGOMERY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

December 2021

This agreement establishes procedures to promote the easy transition of students from Fulton-Montgomery Community College (FMCC) to the Paramedic Associate in Applied Science degree program at the State University of New York College of Agriculture and Technology at Cobleskill (SUNY Cobleskill).

Terms of the Agreement

Students from Fulton-Montgomery Community College who complete the pre-requisites as specified below, with a minimum overall grade point average of 2.25 for the first year of study, will be guaranteed acceptance to SUNY Cobleskill as a second year student. If the class is full, the student will be given the highest priority for the next year.

This guarantee provides the opportunity to complete the SUNY Cobleskill Paramedic Associate in Applied Science degree through the Paramedic Program, normally requiring no more than one year of academic work at Cobleskill, including a summer Field Clinical rotation at one of our affiliate EMS agency sites.

Major Field coursework (BIO 181 & 182 and ENG 103) require grades of C or higher to be accepted for transfer credit.

Additionally, current valid NYS EMT Certification is required prior to registering for EMSC courses.

*SUNY Cobleskill EMSC 112 (Emergency Medical Technician - 4 credits) is challengeable course for students with a current NYS EMT certification. Students needing college credit for EMSC 112 will be registered for EMSC 112 in the same semester as EMSC 201. Every student must maintain NYS EMT certification throughout the duration of paramedic coursework.

Review and Revision of the Agreement

This joint agreement will be reviewed when substantial changes are made in the curriculum on either campus. At the request of either party, a review of the Transfer Articulation Agreement will be conducted by both institutions.

Termination



Effective Date and Signatures


This agreement will become effective December 2021, upon acceptance of Agreement with appropriate signatures.


